- Briefly reviewed progress of by-laws update which is needed because the Association is not currently operating strictly as written. For example, current by-laws state dues be collected monthly and general membership meetings be held monthly. Discussion with members in attendance indicate that quarterly membership meetings would be more useful. By-laws update will be complete and ready for vote at next Annual meeting in July, 2022.
- Short discussion of committees. Current committees are Membership, Keep It Clean and Wayfinding. The Board would like to form a Zoning Committee, but no volunteers have stepped forward.
