TEJAS TRAILS MEMBERS DONATE LIDAR TO FW PD

Several residents of Tejas Trails contributed to the purchase of a LIDAR speed detector that was donated to the West Division of the Fort Worth Police Department. This was in response to our NPO mentioning a lack of equipment as a factor in the lack of patrols for speeding.

NEIGHBORHOOD SECURITY UPDATES BEING CONSIDERED

Past TTNA President, Bob Benda, has approached the board with a recommendation that we look into purchase of Flock cameras. These cameras are capable of recognizing license plates and are now a big part of FWPD preventative and investigative work. They are fairly pricey at \$2500 per year to place one at one end of the neighborhood and would require an increase in the membership dues of roughly \$25 per member to cover it. This topic will be on the agenda for neighborhood discussion at the Annual Meeting in July.

QUARTERLY MEMBERSHIP MEETING

We had a good turnout for the April TTNA quarterly meeting with 40 attendees including members and guests. Guests included our NPOs and their Commander, as well as the Chapel Creek HOA president. The highlight of the meeting was attendance by all 3 candidates running for our District 7 city council position: Caleb Backholm, Jason Ellis and Macy Hill. Each introduced him/herself and gave a brief description of their reasons for running and the focus of their campaign, then it was opened for questions from residents.
